





2018

Same year, AXA launches the AXA Art Prize US to support emerging artistic talent. Building on this success, AXA establishes the AXA Art Prize in the UK in 2022, which draws on a 10-year legacy of a related prize. This initiative highlights AXA's continued commitment to artists and the creative community.

2024


AXA marks the twentieth anniversary of its partnership with TEFAF Maastricht, highlighting their long-standing collaboration within the global art community.
