2018

Building on this success, AXA establishes the AXA Art Prize in the UK in 2022, which draws on a 10-year legacy of a related prize. This initiative highlights AXA's continued commitment to artists and the creative community.

2024

AXA marks the twentieth anniversary of its partnership with TEFAF Maastricht, highlighting their long-standing collaboration within the global art community.

2025
